ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR AND OTHER INCIDENTS OF NOTE

<u>07.03.2023 – Oxenden Crescent, Wingham</u> Two males were seen on Oxenden Crescent trying to sell products. One of the males was seen to enter a property. The resident does have a ring doorbell and CCTV at their property. Police attended the residents address, the males had attended and attempted to sell a variety of items to the resident. The resident initially declined, and the males left. The resident stated they felt they wanted to help the males, so invited one of them back into their property, and purchased a number of items totalling £30. The sale was not forced, although it was thought the items were slightly expensive, the resident decided they wanted to help the males out so agreed to purchase the products on offer. No further concerns were raised. Safeguarding advice was given to the resident and an intelligence form was submitted regarding the salesmen.

<u>25.03.2023 – The Frog & Orange, Shatterling</u> Persons were reported to be trespassing on land behind The Frog and Orange riding moto cross bikes very loudly on private farmland, close to Wingham Wildlife, the field by the orchard. It appeared the land was accessed via the grounds of The Frog and Orange. It was reported 5-6 motorbikes were present and it was unknown if the motor bikes had number plates. The description of the motorbikes was: red, orange and yellow riders with females spectating. Local patrols noted and will pay passing attention to the area.
