- 1. The Rushbeecher Charity, which dates from 1663
- 2. The Rutter Charity, which dates from 1865
- 3. The Wingham Fire Brigade Fund, which dates from 1977

In 1971 the Rushbeecher and Rutter Charities were combined to form the Rushbeecher & Rutter Charity which is registered with the Charity Commission (charity number 212510).

The Wingham Fire Brigade Fund is registered with the Charity Commission (charity number 274064).


