In early Saxon times the Manor of Wingham, one of the richest in Kent, was owned by the Archbishop of Canterbury and in 1286 an Ecclesiastical College was built in the village by Archbishop Peckham. In 1252 a weekly market was established by permission of King Henry III and in 1573 Queen Elizabeth I stayed in the village.
